Financial Loss If you have suffered financial loss, you should contact your bank or credit card provider. Use the number on your Debit or Credit card or dial **159**, which is the official UK short-code telephone number to securely and directly connect you with your bank's fraud department. (Select bank from the options)

Phishing attempts can be simply forwarded to - report@phishing.gov.uk - or if they are text messages, then by forwarding them to **7726**.
